Questions & Answers

- 1. Will the design and layout of the final report be carried out by ReLondon, or should the cost for design be incorporated into the proposal?**

We are looking for the final design and layout of the report to be carried out by the contractor(s). The cost of design needs to be incorporated in the proposal. An easy-to-use template will be provided.

- 2. Will the final deliverables include branding from both ReLondon and the contractor(s)?**

The final deliverables will be in ReLondon branding and style but will include the logo of both ReLondon and the contractor(s). Full credits and acknowledgements will be incorporated into the report.

- 3. Will it be possible to provide relevant London region cuts of data on education & training provision funded by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (held by the GLA/LEP) to the contractor during the project?**

ReLondon will support the contractor(s) in accessing local data by providing relevant connections and making introductions. Education and Skills Funding Agency data may be difficult to access, so bidders should propose a methodology with alternative data options.

- 4. We would like to know if consortia bids would be welcomed for this tender?**

Consortia bids would be welcomed for this tender. However, there would need to be a single point of contact for ReLondon, including on project management, invoicing, and general communications.
